In my role as Chief People Officer, I continually evaluate training and courses that are essential to our success. I have been studying leadership and have evaluated leadership resources throughout my career. The Way of the Hero is singular in how it enables its participants to experience a remarkable personal and leadership transformation. Rather than teach tactics of leadership, the Way of the Hero places participants in conditions that powerfully unlock their awareness of themselves and the world, and thereby their potential. Through preparation of mind and body prior to the trek, each participant embarks on a personal journey of discovery and breakthrough. The learning unfolds for each participant. It isn't learned as much as it discovered individually.

The Way of the Hero isn't for everyone. It is not traditional classroom learning. It is not a pampered tour. There isn't a teacher feeding ideas to students. Rather, it places participants in the conditions that produce personal growth and expansion. Upon a participant's return, the world looks completely different although the world hasn't changed – how the participant sees themselves in relation to the world has transformed. In my own experience with Way of the Hero 18 months ago, we cycled through northern Europe over 12 days and 600+ miles. And yet the distance is irrelevant because the success was not measured in miles but in moments – moments of self-discovery, vulnerability and personal growth. The Way of the Hero Trek provided me the opportunity to know myself and in many ways overcome myself and has done more for my ability to lead and empower others than any other work I have done.



I shared my experience with leaders at my company and couldn't hold back emotions of joy, gratitude and personal triumph. It ignited an unstoppable compulsion of some fellow leaders to join the trek of the Way of the Hero in New Zealand last fall. Each participant came back changed. More forgiving of themselves and others. More aware. More mindful. More alive. - Learn to focus on what is most essential.

And participants return empowered and driven to guide others on their own journey to growth and development.
